Important Points to Remember



Using email to communicate with your TVA teachers is essential.

Communication

It is very important that both student and parent communicate with TVA teachers and Mrs. Kindoll. Please allow 24 hours Monday-Friday (not including holidays or weekends) for TVA teachers to respond to questions. If you don't hear from a teacher, please contact Mrs. Kindoll. You are welcome to copy any emails to teachers to Mrs. Kindoll to keep her informed about questions, concerns, or class questions. Please check your email daily for important announcements and due dates.

Attendance

You must log in to the TVA homeroom daily between 12:00am and 11:59pm on any day that Tulpehocken SD has school (please refer to the school calendar). If you are unable to log in for any reason, you must call or email Mrs. Kindoll that day to be excused. Excuse blanks will need to be submitted within 3 days via scan/email. Remember the expectation for daily work is

- 45 min/day/class for grades K-5 using Accelerate plus additional time for reading/worksheets
- 60 min/day/class for grades 6-12 using Edgenuity, Google, and/or VHS.
- 75 min/day/class for Honors or AP level classes



Attendance is checked each day that Tulpehocken has school.

A Team Approach

TVA teachers work closely with Mrs. Kindoll to provide updates on grades and provide the best program for each student.

While we use most of our own teachers, we also utilize teachers from some of our vendors. We suggest contacting the teacher/vendor first to discuss any questions or concerns. If you need more clarification, please contact Mrs. Kindoll. She can work with the student and teacher to resolve any issues.

Online learning requires a commitment on the part of the student to be self-motivated and self-disciplined. The parent(s) or guardian(s) also play a important role by checking on their student and asking questions about assignments, just like they would for a traditional student. Parent access to TVA progress reports and Sapphire Web Portal can help a parent keep track of assignments and grades.
