Here are some general guidelines:

Helpful tips for ImPACT testing

To ensure a valid test, please follow the following instructions. It is very important that you can fully concentrate during the entire test. <u>Poor performance may result in an invalid test and will require a re-take</u>.

- Set aside 45 minutes in a quiet room with no distractions.
- Don't use headphones or a cell phone during the test.
- Turn off the television, radio, or anything else that can produce background noise.
- Tell siblings and family members about the importance of the test to avoid interruptions or distractions.

About the test

- The test will begin by asking you background questions. This is called the "demographic" section.
- There are 6 test sections, or modules. These include word memory, design memory, Xs and Os, symbol match, color word match and three letters.
- Take your time to read each section's instructions carefully. Each module is self explanatory.
- If the directions say "for speed", complete the task as fast as you can.
- It is common to perform the color word match module incorrectly, please read that section's instructions thoroughly. <u>If you are color blind, do NOT click on any of the colors - Basically do NOTHING. It will then ask you</u> if you are color blind.
- Other than the initial demographic section, do not ask anyone to help you during the test, such as assistance with memory questions. Do not write anything down during the test to aid memory.
- You should use a standard external mouse if possible. A laptop track pad can be used if needed. Please make sure to mark which method you used. This test cannot be done on a tablet.

Taking the Test

****Make sure your pop-up blocker is turned off****

Enter the customer code AZYV8QSNXT and click validate.

Select Tulpehocken Area School District from the dropdown list and click Launch Test

Select your desired language.

Answer all the demographic questions including the additional demographic section.

Complete the baseline symptom section. Baseline means how you typically feel each day.

Take the test.

You do <u>NOT</u> need to print the report. We will be notified when you have completed the test.
