JR. HIGH BOYS SOCCER RULE

All rules concerning PIAA and the Tulpehocken School District Student code of Responsibility will be strictly enforced.

PRACTICE

- 1) All Practices are mandatory. If there is any reason for you to miss, it must be discussed with the coaches prior to the day of absence.
- 2) An unexcused absence will reflect in your playing time.
- 3) Every player is expected to be on time for practice.
- 4) All players are expected to show up at practice ready to go (all equipment, water bottles, inhalers etc.).
- 5) We will practice the way we play with our shirttails tucked in and all equipment in place.
- 6) I expect all players to come to practice ready to work hard, listen, and give their best effort. Anything less will not be tolerated.
- 7) The coaching staff will always be addressed as Coach.
- 8) Any dissention between player and coach or between teammates will be punished by suspension.

GAMES

- 1) Players will wear no type of head gear during game preparation or after a game until we have left the field. Keepers must have coaches' approval on any headgear.
- 2) Players are NOT allowed to talk to referees unless instructed by the coaching staff to do so.
- 3) Any foul language will not be tolerated and will result in suspension.
- 4) Players receiving yellow or red cards will be dealt with at the coaches' discretion.

BUS TRAVEL

- 1) All players will travel to games on the bus. Players may be signed out after the completion of both games by their parent or legal guardian with the appropriate form (attached). No one else can sign out your child or take them home.
- 2) Cell phones shall be used to call your parents to let them know any information that is important to soccer (arrival time back at the school, etc.).
- 3) Players are allowed devices to listen to music but with headphones only.
- 4) Players may bring food as long as we keep our areas clean.
- 5) Any throwing of food or other objects will result in losing your bus privileges. This means you will not be able to travel to away games.
- 6) All Tulpehocken Area School District bus rules apply.
- 7) When riding the bus to a game players should get focused and not be messing around.

Always remember you are representing the Tulpehocken School District and its soccer program, so make sure you represent our great tradition.
