Applications for 2023-2024

Opens on 10/15 (first day to apply)
Due 11/18

Ninth graders, who are interested in BCTC for a 10th-12th grade program, or upper level students wanting to start at BCTC must complete the online application and submit the appropriate paperwork to the guidance office no later than November 18.

The process to apply includes the following:

- 1) Complete the online application.
- 2) Complete the following and give to Mrs. Yenser, School Counselor.
 - ⇒ Two (2) Teacher Recommendation forms. Students are responsible for getting the forms to their teachers.
 - ⇒ BCTC essay (which was written in 9th Grade English classes)
 - ⇒ BCTC Admissions Agreement with parent/guardian signature.

Many programs fill up quickly, so it's imperative that students submit application material by the deadline.
