Applications for 2024-2025

Ninth graders, who are interested in BCTC for a 10th-12th grade program, and upper level students who want to start at BCTC in any program including MHP must complete the online application and submit the appropriate paperwork to the guidance office <u>no later than</u> November 17.

The process to apply includes the following:

- 1) Complete the online application.
- 2) Complete the following and submit to the guidance office.
 - ⇒ Two (2) Teacher Recommendation forms. Students are responsible for getting the forms to their teachers.
 - ⇒ BCTC essay (which was written in 9th Grade English classes)
 - ⇒ BCTC Admissions Agreement with parent/guardian signature.

Pennsylvania Department of Education: Career Education and Work Standards

Tulpehocken Area School District follows a set of standards required by the Pennsylvania Department of Education to provide activities in career development and employability skills for our students. Through exploring interests, aptitudes, learning styles, personality traits, career options, as well as high school and post-secondary education options, students can develop a career plan that best fits who they are as a person. Middle School Career Lessons

Students in 7th and 8th grade will continue their career exploration with two career lessons this year. In October, 7th graders are introduced to Choices 360, a career planning program for decisions about educational and career goals. Students match interests and personal qualities to Career Clusters to explore future options. Later in the year, students explore aspects of business ownership for a greater understanding of entrepreneurship.

The first 8th grade lesson explores traits that make a good employee. Not only are there skills valuable in the world of work, but are importation for success in school, athletics, community activities and life.

The culmination of middle school lessons is a career plan where students develop a career plan based on their career choice. Students can modify and enhance their plan throughout their high school years as they further explore careers, education, and the world of work.
