9th Grade BCTC Presentation and Tours

Ninth grade students will attended a Berks Career and Technology Center assembly on September 15 to learn about BCTC and its programs. SAT and College Admissions

The COVID-19 pandemic had a major impact on the college admissions process. Many U.S. colleges have made the submission of SAT scores optional in the admissions process or eliminated them. What does that mean for the students who will be applying to colleges this year?

What Does Test Optional Mean?

Students have the option to submit their SAT/ACT scores to the college to be used in the admissions process. At these schools, students will <u>not</u> be penalized for <u>not</u> submitting a score. However, pay close attention of any stipulations. The SAT could be test optional for everyone or only for those with a specific GPA. Some schools may require the SAT for specific programs, but not for all of them. If you submit your scores, they <u>will</u> be used in the admissions process. If you did not score well, you may not want to submit scores.

Although a school may not require SATs for the admissions application, they <u>may still be required</u> for <u>scholarships</u>. Some merit scholarships are based on a students GPA and SAT scores. Make sure to check with your school if SAT scores are required. At this point, it is wise to take the SAT in case you need it.

Athletes planning to play Division I or II sports MUST take the SAT since it is required for NCAAA eligibility.
