

## <u>Cricket</u> (European version of baseball) (In PE we will play "Kwik-Cricket")

## Rules:

- 1. Team members bat in pairs. As one teammate bats, the other is at the far set of wickets.
- 2. There are no foul balls and no out of bounds.
- 3. The batter's main goal is to protect the wickets behind him.
- 4. The batting team is NOT required to run when the ball is hit, but they cannot score without running.
- 5. Both people who are batting must run at the same time.
- 6. Each time the 2 batters exchange places, they score a run.
- 7. The number of runs they score is unlimited.
- 8. The bat MUST be carried along with the batter and his/her partner.
- 9. The number of pitches to each pair is determined by the size of the class.
- 10. The team of batters is out when:
  - The batted ball is caught in the air.
  - The pitched ball hits the wicket.
  - The fielding team hits the wicket with the ball or knocks over the wicket before both runners are behind the line.
  - The team has had the allotted number of pitches.
- 11. Each pair of teammates from the one team bats before the other team becomes the batting team. Outs are not counted.

## Terminology:

- 1. Wickets the sets of 3 sticks that are behind the batter.
- 2. Bat the stick that is used to hit the ball. It is flat on the one side and rounded on the other.
- 3. Pitch allotment the number of pitches that each batting team is allowed.
