TVA students can also choose to work full-time at home on their courses or part-time (hybrid). In grades 7-12, we also offer students the option to work on their online classes in our JSHS library in either a full-time or part-time model. 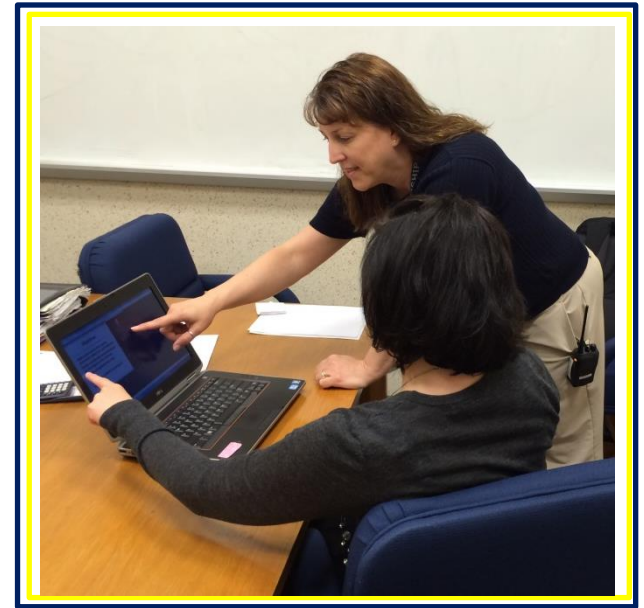

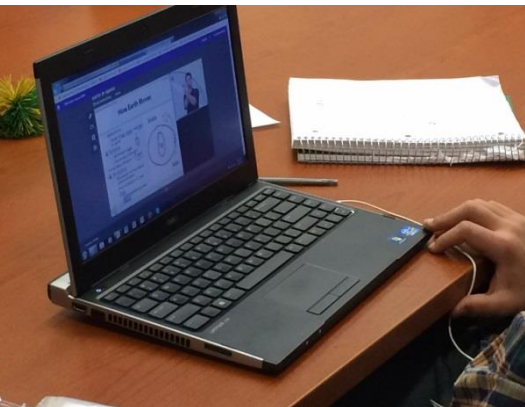

Tulpehocken Virtual Academy

TVA is the Tulpehocken Area School District's cyber school established in the 2009-2010 school year. We offer full-time, part-time, and hybrid online programs for students in grades K-12.

Providers >>>

TVA uses several different providers for curriculum. Each provides a unique learning environment for students.

Accelerate Education is available for grades K-5 and provides workbooks for students as well as online materials. Parents act as a learning coach to assist students with learning at home. Elementary students have the choice to take online specials or attend specials in the building.

Google Classroom is used for any unique to Tulpehocken

classes such as Driver Ed, Contemporary Living or TVA Homeroom which is used for daily attendance.

Edgenuity is for grades 7-12 and this provider uses videos and interactive tools to deliver content. Edgenuity has mastery-based lessons which allows students to have multiple attempts at quizzes, tests, and exams.

Virtual High School provides online electives for students in grades 7-12 and has a huge catalog of unique courses as well as Honors and AP level courses.

Opportunities >>>

TVA students can participate in any activities that our brick and mortar students are eligible for. Events such as assemblies, music programs, field trips, clubs, dances, and athletics are all options that TVA students can choose from. Graduating seniors receive a TASD diploma.

Commitment >>>>

Students must be committed to online learning with motivation and self-discipline. Parents/Guardians should also be aware of the time commitment that comes along with online learning. Online learning can be just as challenging or even more so than traditional methods.
