

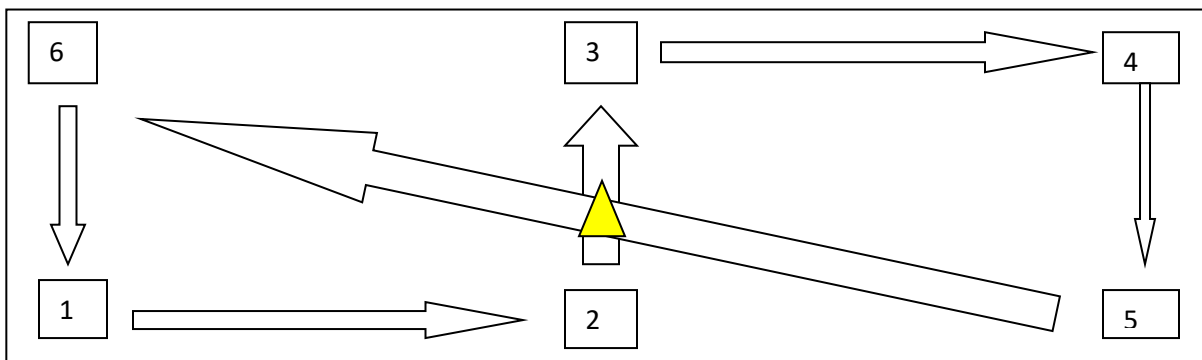



Colony Kickball

Colony kickball is a type of kickball played with an indoor foam coated soccerball. Gym mats are used instead of bases.

Rules:

1. Bases are run in order. There are 6 bases.
2. The ball must be kicked a minimum distance forward. This is set by the teacher.
3. When a player kicks the ball, the runner runs to all six bases in order. The bases are set up in this order.



4. Players must be cautious at this point. 
5. There are no force outs except at 1st base.
6. A player may stay on a base as long as he/she wants.
7. There may be any number of players on a base at any time.
8. A player is out if:
 - He is tagged with the ball
 - A thrown ball hits him below the shoulders
 - He is hit by a kicked ball
 - The kicked ball is caught before hitting the floor, including off the walls or bleachers.
 - Forced out at 1st base
9. Each team is allowed 5 outs per inning. A ball that is kicked into the ceiling or is kicked onto the batting cage net is an automatic 5 outs. When the 5th out is made all runners will return to their last occupied base at the time the out was made for the start of their next "at bat"
10. Runners may not run or leave the base :
 - When the pitcher has the ball
 - Until the ball is kicked
11. Fielders may not prevent a runner from advancing.
