



## Krazy Kickball

Krazy kickball is a type of kickball played with a playground ball. Gym mats are used instead of bases.

Rules:

1. Bases are run in reverse order. There is also a safety base to the right of the kicker.
2. There are no foul balls.
3. When a player kicks the ball, he has a choice of going to 1<sup>st</sup> base or to the safety base.
4. Players must go around the bases twice to score a run, ending on the safety base.
5. There are no force outs.
6. A player may stay on a base as long as he wants.
7. There may be any number of players on a base at any time.
8. A player is out if:
  - He is tagged with the ball
  - A thrown ball hits him below the shoulders
  - He is hit by a kicked ball
  - The kicked ball is caught before hitting the floor, including off the walls or bleachers.
9. Each team is allowed 5 outs per inning. A ball that is kicked into the ceiling or is kicked onto the batting cage net is an automatic 5 outs.
10. Runners may run at any time. This includes:
  - When the pitcher has the ball
  - When the ball is kicked
  - When the ball is thrown at another player
  - When the ball is caught
11. Fielders may not prevent a runner from advancing.
12. A runner may not return to a base after he leaves.

A variation of this game is Wacky Whiffleball, where the ball is batted instead of kicked.
